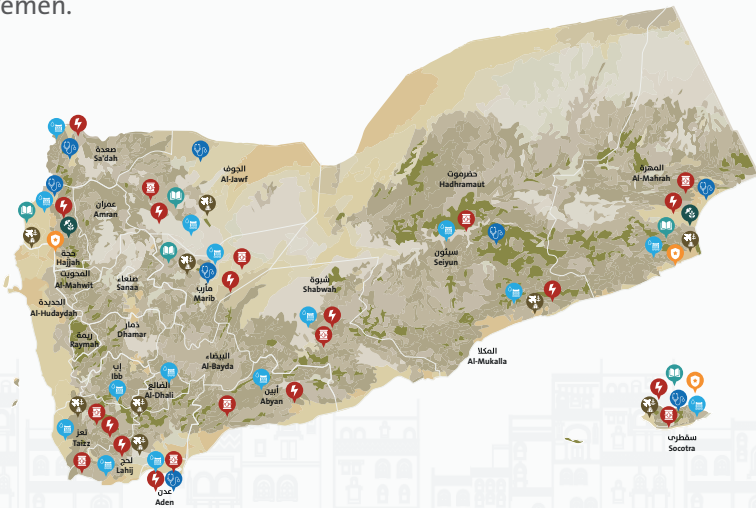


SAUDI DEVELOPMENT AND RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM FOR YEMEN

Overview of Activity: March 2020

The Saudi Development and Reconstruction Program for Yemen (SDRPY) is a strategic initiative launched in 2018 by decree of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, King Salman bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud, to support Yemen in its efforts toward reconstruction through the improvement of basic services and total economic, social and environmental recovery. SDRPY contributes to enhancing infrastructure, improving livelihoods, advancing economic growth, strengthening stability and security, nurturing peace, and helping Yemenis themselves to pave the way to a future of sustainable prosperity. As SDRPY adopts best practices in development and reconstruction, Saudi Arabia's unique historical, cultural and economic relationship to Yemen reinforces the program's thought leadership in the field of Yemen's sustainable development.

As of February 2020, SDRPY had launched over 173 projects in partnership with 51 Yemeni companies in 7 key sectors through its offices in 8 Yemeni governorates. The program currently operates in a majority of the country's provinces and plans to expand operations to all of Yemen. SDRPY conceives and designs projects and initiatives in close cooperation with the legitimate government and local authorities with a view to creating job opportunities, building capacity, transferring knowledge, empowering communities, and helping all Yemenis impartially, irrespective of origin, affiliation, gender or location. The operational scope of SDRPY makes the program a cornerstone for a comprehensive solution to the situation in Yemen.



FACILITATING ACCESS TO CLEAN WATER

- Construction of water distribution facilities
- Expansion of water distribution networks
- Construction of a 20-km water conveyor line
- Construction of water towers and tanks
- Supply of 252 water tankers
- Drilling of 58 wells



FACILITATING AND EQUALIZING ACCESS TO EDUCATION AND CREATING PROPER LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

- Construction and renovation of over 25 schools ready for 23,400 students annually
- Printing, delivery and distribution of over 500,000 school books to 150 schools
- Delivery of book bags and desks
- Supply of school buses for 20,000 students



OPTIMIZING DAILY ELECTRICITY USAGE AND ENCOURAGING THE USE OF CLEAN ENERGY

- Supply of oil derivatives to 64 power plants across 10 governorates,
- Supply of high-capacity generators
- Construction of power stations
- Provision of 590 solar powered outdoor lights



EXPANDING PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE AND IMPROVING EFFICIENCY OF GOVERNMENT INSTITUTIONS AND BORDER SECURITY

- Construction and renovation of coast guard stations on Arabian and Red Sea coasts
- Construction and equipment of national security and anti-terrorism facilities
- Construction and equipment of border stations



BUILDING CAPACITY AND TRANSFERRING KNOWLEDGE

- 90 personnel trained in life skills
- 138 medical professional trained
- Central Bank of Yemen personnel trained
- Foreign Ministry of Yemen personnel trained



INCREASING TRANSPORTATION EFFICIENCY AND VOLUMES OF HUMANITARIAN AND COMMERCIAL IMPORTS

- Expansion of ports on all Yemeni seas
- Construction of 2 international airports
- Repair and reconstruction of major roads
- Supply of fire and emergency vehicles
- Supply of buses for public transportation



IMPROVING HEALTHCARE ACCESS AND SERVICE STANDARDS IN THE COMMUNITIES

- Renovation and reequipment of 7 general hospitals and healthcare facilities
- Construction of a cardiology center
- Operation and maintenance of hospitals
- Construction of emergency rooms and operating theaters
- Construction of intensive care units
- Establishment of specialized clinics
- Construction of 20-bed-capacity kidney dialysis center
- Renovation and increase in operational capacity of maternity and child care centers through supply of 37 pieces of state-of-the-art medical devices
- Construction of health centers in remote districts
- Supply of 6 ambulances
- Design and construction of 100-bed teaching hospital and adjoining university with 4 colleges of sciences



INCREASING PRODUCTIVITY OF AGRICULTURAL AND FISHING FACILITIES FOR GREATER FOOD SELF-SUFFICIENCY

- Supply of 220 boats, refrigerated containers, equipment and outboard motors to Arabian and Red Sea coast fishermen vulnerable to cyclones and natural disasters
- Construction of a boat maintenance shop
- Rehabilitation of agricultural land
- Construction and maintenance of 22 greenhouses
- Supply of 18 installments of tractors and farming equipment
- Supply of organic fertilizer and seeds
- Supply of irrigation water
- Cultivation of 485,623 m2 of wheat
